The Solarcontainer is a photovoltaic power plant that was specially developed as a mobile power generator with collapsible PV modules as a mobile solar system, a grid-independent solution represents. The unfolded panels can reach up to 120 meters in length, and there are 240 solar panels that can be installed. The Solarcontainer is a mobile system that can be used for both on- and off-grid purposes, including rescue missions and gatherings. the foldable photovoltaic panels are tucked inside a mobile solar container

The on-grid version of the solarfold container is connected directly to the public power grid and can supply up to 40 single-family homes with the energy produced (energy requirement of 3,500 kW/year/single-family house). The solarfold on-grid container can also be expanded with various storage solutions.

The Austrian energy company SolarCont has developed a mobile solar container that stores foldable photovoltaic panels for portable green energy anywhere.

This setup enables easy transport of the mobile solar container via cargo ship vessels, trains, and trucks too, given that the rail system can be stashed until it fits the container's frame. the unfolded panels can reach up to 120 meters in length, and around 240 solar panels can be installed

SolarCont states that at least three or four people, excluding the crane operator, may be needed to set up the Solarcontainer into operation within one day. The Solarcontainer can also be lifted or shifted without a foundation, but if the user faces harsh wind conditions, ballast stones can be placed on the rail system if needed.
