With acute urinary retention, a health care professional will immediately drain the urine from your bladder using a catheter. Removing the urine from the bladder eases your pain and helps prevent your bladder and kidneys from being damaged.

<div class="df_qntext">What happens if you have urinary retention after surgery?

Many people experience urinary retention right after surgery. Normal bladder function usually returns once the anaesthetic wears off. Urinary retention after an operation doesn't usually cause any long-term problems. If urinary retention is expected, then a catheter will be used. Some medicines may sometimes cause urinary retention.

Acute urinary retention is a medical emergency. Your healthcare provider will insert a catheter to drain your bladder, which should provide almost immediate relief. After that, they will work to determine the cause and the appropriate treatment.

<div class="df_qntext">What if I have chronic urinary retention?

If you have chronic urinary retention, your health care professional will first try to diagnose and treat the cause of your retention. However, your health care professional may need to use a catheter to drain the urine from your bladder if the retention continues or becomes severe.

Urinary retention is a condition where your bladder doesn't empty all the way or at all when you urinate (pee). This happens when the muscles in your bladder don't work properly, or there's a blockage preventing urine from flowing out.

Urinary retention can be caused by blockages, medications, and nerve problems. If you experience acute urinary retention, it's an emergency and you should see a healthcare provider right away. Chronic urinary retention is more common in men aged 60 to 80.
