Residential roof-mounted solar PV permits, including combination solar PV permits with electrical service upgrade and/or advance energy storage systems, are available online through the Planning & Development Services (County of San Diego) Citizen Access.

PV panels we see are actually large clusters of solar cells, each made with semiconductors which absorb a tiny fraction of the sun's energy and convert it to electricity.
