In 278 BC, learning of the capture of his country's capital, Ying, by General Bai Qi of the state of Qin, Qu Yuan is said to have collected folktales and written the lengthy poem of lamentation called Lament for Ying. Eventually, he died by suicide, wading into the Miluo River in today's Hunan Province while holding a rock.

Associate Professor Li Xiangzhen, from the School of Sociology at Wuhan University, notes that Qu Yuan's eternal legacy lies in his literary works and his political aspirations, which always saw him stand on the side of the people. His greatness is marked by his profound compassion for his country and his fervent loyalty to the monarchy.

His highly original and imaginative verse had an enormous influence over early Chinese poetry. Qu Yuan was born a member of the ruling house of Chu, a large state in the central valley of the Yangtze River (Chang Jiang).
