<div class="df_qntext">How did First Solar perform in Q2 2025?

First Solar, Inc. (Nasdaq: FSLR) announced financial results for the second quarter ended June 30, 2025. Net sales for the quarter were \$1.1 billion, an increase of \$0.3 billion from the prior quarter.

<div class="df_qntext">How did the US solar industry perform in Q1 2025?

The US solar industry installed 10.8 gigawatts direct current (GWdc) of capacity in Q1 2025, a 7% decline from Q1 2024 and a 43% decrease compared with Q4 2024 but still the fourth largest quarter on record. Solar accounted for 69% of all new electricity-generating capacity added to the US grid in Q1 2025.

<div class="df_qntext">How much will the US solar industry contract in 2025?

The US solar industry is projected to contract by 2% annually between 2025 and 2030 in our Base case but still add nearly 43 GWdc on average each year. In the near term, solar installations will decline at an average rate of 7% from 2025 to 2027.

<div class="df_qntext">How did California's solar market perform in Q1 2024?

Commercial solar grew by 4%, installing 486 MWdc, making it the only solar segment to increase compared to Q1 2024. California's NEM 2.0 installations continued to fuel the commercial segment, with the state adding more than 200 MWdc in Q1. Community solar installations, however, dropped significantly to 244 MWdc after a massive fourth quarter.

<div class="df_qntext">How much solar capacity did the residential segment install in Q1 2025?

Utility-scale projects dominated installations in both states. In Q1 2025, the residential segment installed 1,106 MWdc of solar capacity, declining 13% year-over-year and 4% quarter-over-quarter. High interest rates and economic uncertainty continued to suppress demand.

<div class="df_qntext">How much solar power does the US have in Q1 2025?

Solar accounted for 69% of all new electricity-generating capacity added to the US grid in Q1 2025. The US added 8.6 GW of solar module manufacturing capacity in Q1, bringing the total to 51 GW. However, growth in upstream manufacturing capacity remains slow or non-existent.
