The Solarcontainer is a photovoltaic power plant that was specially developed as a mobile power generator with collapsible PV modules as a mobile solar system, a grid-independent solution represents. "PNCT's impressive solar installation marks a major step forward in the Port of New York and New Jersey's steadfast transition to cleaner, more sustainable operations," said Port Authority Executive Director Rick Cotton.

<div class="df_qntext">How many households can a solar Container Supply?

Based on an average power consumption of a 4-person household of 4000 kWh per year and a location in Southern Germany, the solar container can supply approx. 32 households with climate-friendly electricity. At a location in Southern Europe it can even be up to 50 households due to the high solar radiation.

<div class="df_qntext">How does a Solar System benefit Newark Airport?

The solar installation now generates 50 percent of the terminal's annual energy needs, greatly reducing emissions and improving air quality. In addition to generating power for terminal operations, the system has the ability to feed excess power into the regional utility grid, providing clean energy to the city of Newark and nearby areas.

The industry-leading solar project is the foundation of a long-term strategy for growth and environmental stewardship envisioned by PNCT, in partnership with Newark Mayor Ras Baraka and the Port Authority.
